Thursday and Friday when an FDA advisory panel will recommend whether to back booster doses of both the J&J and Moderna vaccines. That's one step in the government's vaccine review process: Next week, the FDA will make a final decision on authorizing those boosters and then the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention will debate who actually should get them.

An FDA advisory panel voted unanimously to endorse a half-dose booster of Moderna Inc.'s COVID-19 vaccine for people 65 and older and young adults with high-risk jobs or medical conditions, with the shot to be administered at least six months after the second dose. (The New York Times) The committee will reconvene today for an authorization vote on whether Johnson & Johnson's one-dose vaccine merits a booster shot.

The FDA will call its committee of outside advisers for a Nov. 30 meeting on Merck & Co.'s antiviral drug to treat COVID-19, marking the first time the agency has assembled its group of independent experts before ruling on a treatment for the illness. With a vote likely slated for that day, a decision on authorization won't be expected until December, though the FDA is not obligated to go along with the panel's recommendation.

The FDA is being very careful and wants more time to study the risk of a rare inflammatory heart condition before approving the Moderna vaccine for adolescents, NIH Director Francis Collins says on MSNBC.

- The FDA is pushing back a decision on whether to authorize Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine for children ages 12-17, people familiar with the matter said, giving the agency time to more closely scrutinize a potential connection between the shot and a rare heart condition known as myocarditis in younger men.

FDA authorization of booster shots from Moderna Inc. and Johnson & Johnson is expected by tomorrow evening.
