

2022 ELECTION NIGHT RACES TO WATCH

(Incumbents Member/Party in **BOLD** – Democrats are listed first)

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Republicans need to win a net four seats to gain the majority in the House.

According to the Cook Political Report, the breakdown of House seats *in play* is as follows:

Basically this means that the Democrats will be defending more seats on election night than the Republicans.

SENATE

In the Senate, we have a different story. Senate Democrats control 48 seats (two independent seats caucus with the Democrats; however, those seats are not up for election this year). There are 35 seats up for reelection in 2022: 14 are held by Democrats and 21 are held by Republicans – so from the get-go Republicans are defending more seats.

Of those 35 that will be decided this November, eight are considered safe Democratic seats: CA, CT, HI, IL, MD, NY, OR and VT. Fourteen are likely or solid Republican: AK, AL, AR, ID, IN, KS, KY, LA, MO, ND, OK (two open seats) SC and SD. According to the Cook Political Report, the following 13 seats are the ones to watch.

ELECTION NIGHT RESULTS

Every state has different rules about the timing for when absentee/mail-in ballots can be processed, when they can be tabulated and when results can be released. Keep in mind, some states do *not* allow processing or counting of absentee/mail-in ballots prior to election day or to the closing of the polls. You will recall that in Pennsylvania, President Donald Trump was winning on election day, but once absentee and mail-in ballots were counted, Joe Biden ended up winning the state. Once the polls close and results of election day voting are released, we can expect a long night – or even days – of drama as states tally absentee and mail-in ballots. As of Friday, November 4, 2022, over 34 million mail-in and early in-person votes had been cast.
