**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF’S UNOPPOSED MOTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing in this order shall preclude the Court-appointed receiver, Jennifer Ecklund, from performing the duties and obligations and from exercising the powers and rights set forth in the Court's Amended Order Appointing Receiver (Dkt. #48).
