| January 26, 2018 | Deadline for Plaintiff to file amended pleadings (A motion for leave to amend is required.) |
| May 9, 2018 | Defendants' disclosure of expert testimony pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2) and Local Rule CV-26(b) |

¹ If a deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday as defined in Fed. R. Civ. P. 6, the effective date is the first federal court business day following the deadline imposed.

May 9, 2018	Deadline for Defendant's final amended pleadings (A motion for leave to amend is required.)
6 weeks after disclosure of an expert is made	Deadline to object to any other party's expert witnesses. Objection shall be made as a motion to strike or limit expert testimony and shall be accompanied by a copy of the expert's report in order to provide the Court with all the information necessary to make a ruling on any objection.
May 9, 2018	Deadline for motions to dismiss, motions for summary judgment, or other dispositive motions.
July 19, 2018	All discovery shall be commenced in time to be completed by this date.
August 15, 2018	Notice of intent to offer certified records
August 15, 2018	Counsel and unrepresented parties are each responsible for contacting opposing counsel and unrepresented parties to determine how they will prepare the Joint Final Pretrial Order and Joint Proposed Jury Instructions and Verdict Form (or Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in non-jury cases).
August 21, 2018	Video Deposition Designation due. Each party who proposes to offer a deposition by video shall serve on all other parties a disclosure identifying the line and page numbers to be offered. All other parties will have seven calendar days to serve a response with any objections and requesting cross examination line and page numbers to be included. Counsel must consult on any objections and only those which cannot be resolved shall be presented to the Court. The party who filed the initial Video Deposition Designation is responsible for preparation of the final edited video in accordance with all parties' designations and the Court's rulings on objections.
August 24, 2018	Motions in limine due File Joint Final Pretrial Order (<i>See</i> www.txed.uscourts.gov).
September 14, 2018	Response to motions in limine due File objections to witnesses, deposition extracts, and exhibits, listed in pre-trial order. (This does not extend deadline to object to expert witnesses.) File Proposed Jury Instructions/Form of Verdict (or Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law)

Date will be set by Court.
Usually within 10 days prior
to final pretrial conf.

If numerous objections are filed the Court may set a
hearing to consider all pending motions and objections.
