

STATEMENT REGARDING RECENT OFFERS TO REPRESENT INVESTORS

It has come to the Receiver's attention that some investors have received letters, such as the one [here](#), in which attorneys offer to pursue potential claims against third parties who had business relationships with the Defendants and Relief Defendants in the Millennium Bank Receivership. While the Receiver cannot give legal advice to investors regarding how they should proceed with regard to these offers, he would like to clarify that the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas has specifically granted the Receiver the authority to pursue this type of action when available and warranted. Consistent with the Court's Order, the Receiver has already been in contact with a number of businesses and has secured assets and information that benefit the Receivership Estate.

Further, the Receiver is consistently reviewing all potential sources of assets that are subject to the Receivership Estate and can be secured for the investors' and other claimants' benefit, including potential claims against third parties.
