ORDER APPROVING FIRST AND FINAL INTERIM FEE APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES BY LIMITED COUNSEL TO RECEIVER

On this date, the Court considered Hedrick Kring, PLLC's ("HK") First and Final Interim Fee Application for Allowance of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses by Limited Counsel to Receiver (the "Fee Application" - Dkt. #385). The Court, having considered the relief requested in the Fee Application, the invoices submitted in support, and the Certification included therein, finds that proper and adequate notice of the Fee Application has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary and that the Professional Fees during the Application Period defined in the Fee Application totaling \$14,083.50 (the "Fees and Expenses"), are reasonable and appropriate for the work performed and the expenses incurred.

The Court further finds that during the time period covered by the Fee Application, the time spent, services performed, hourly rates charged, and expenses incurred by HK as Receiver Jennifer Ecklund's retained professionals, were reasonable and necessary for the Receiver to perform her

Therefore, the Court is of the opinion that the relief requested in the Fee Application should be and is **GRANTED**.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

- The Fees and Expenses, totaling \$14,083.50, are approved, on an interim basis (the "Approved Fees and Expenses").
- The Court authorizes immediate payment of the Approved Fees and Expenses to HK.
